





SUBJECT: Submission of Reports for the Impact Assessment of Maximum Drug Retail Price (MDRP)/ Government Mediated Access Price (G-MAP) initiatives.

DATE: February 12, 2010

Pursuant to the Maximum Drug Retail Price (MDRP) policy through Executive Order No.821 and the Government Mediated Access-Price (GMA-P) initiative which took effect last August 15, 2009, the Department of Health through the National Center for Pharmaceutical Access and Management (NCPAM) is conducting a review of the impact by these interventions.

In this light, may we ask your assistance to gather information on how the MDRP and G-MAP has improved the access to medicines in the public sector. We are looking into:

- 1.) How medicines directly affected by the MDRP/G-MAP were made more available and affordable to public sector procurement.
- 2.) How medicines in the same therapeutic categories as those under the MDRP/G-MAP that were indirectly affected (eg. Losartan) have led to the availability and affordability of medicines.

- 3.) If there is an increase or decrease in the prescriptions of doctors received in your pharmacies covering the medicines affected by the intervention (MDRP/G-MAP)
- 4.) Any reports on the impact of the initiative in your designated area of jurisdiction will be greatly appreciated.
