**DEPARTMENT MEMORANDUM:**

**FOR: ALL CHIEFS OF LEVEL II MEDICAL CENTERS, HOSPITALS AND SANITARIA; AND OTHERS CONCERNED**

**SUBJECT: Conduct of the Antimicrobial Stewardship Training for all Level II Hospitals in the Philippines**

The Department of Health–Pharmaceutical Division (DOH-PD), with support from the World Health Organization (WHO) has established the National Antimicrobial Stewardship (AMS) program with the following objectives: (1) to institutionalize leadership and mechanisms for clinical governance in the area of Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR); (2) to establish positive behavioral changes in terms of antimicrobial prescribing, dispensing and use as shown by prescription monitoring; and, (3) to prevent further spread of multi-drug resistant pathogens in the hospital and its surrounding community. The DOH started a stream of interventions through the conduct of Training-of-Trainers Workshop on the AMS Advocacy Package to hospital managers of selected institutions in March and September 2015.

In 2016, the Manual of Procedures (MOPs) for Implementing AMS Programs in Hospitals was developed. It is supported by separate modules for physicians, pharmacists and allied health professionals including nurses, medical technologists and microbiologists. The DOH has set a timeline that all hospitals both public and private, shall be trained on AMS by the end of 2020.

In relation to the regional and country-wide initiative to institutionalize the AMS program in the Philippines, a four-day program for the General AMS Training and the AMS Training Package for Pharmacists and Allied Health Professionals shall be conducted in several batches by the training hubs (ie. Jose B. Lingad Memorial Regional Hospital, Research Institute for Tropical Medicine, Corazon Locsin Montelibano Memorial Regional Hospital, Southern Philippines Medical Center, and Philippine General Hospital) identified by the DOH. Relative thereto, the following personnel shall be invited to participate (sending of representatives are discouraged):

1. Infection Control Committee (ICC) Chair or AMS Chair;
2. Chief of the Microbiology Laboratory or medical technologist;
3. Infection Control Nurse;
4. Chief Pharmacist; and
5. Clinical Pharmacist (or with equivalent training and experience).

The formal invitation and schedule shall be provided by the training hubs to each institution listed in the Annex A. Attendance to the scheduled training is required to ensure that the DOH timeline is achieved. It will also be part of the licensing requirements of the Health

Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau (HFSRB) along with the AMS Program implementation in hospitals in the future.
