Dear **Secretary Garin:**

After evaluating the documents submitted by the proponents pertinent to requests for reconsideration on the inclusion of the below listed medicines to the Philippine National Formulary (PNF), the Formulary Executive Council (FEC) respectfully recommends the **DISAPPROVAL** of the said requests:

- 1) Vildagliptin + Metformin 50 mg/ 500 mg, 50mg/850mg, 50mg/1000mg film coated tablet
- 2) Sulodexide 300 LSU/mL (600 LSU/2 mL) solution for injection (IM/IV), 250 LSU softgel capsule
- 3) Ezetimibe 10 mg tablet
- 4) Paliperidone palmitate 50 mg/0.5 mL, 75 mg/0.75 ml, 100 mg/ml, 150 mg/1.5 ml prolonged release suspension for injection
- 5) Ketoanalogues + essential amino acids (fixed dose combination)
- 6) Racecadotril 100 mg capsule, 10 mg and 30 mg sachet oral powder
- 7) Bortezomib 3.5 mg/vial powder for injection
- 8) Zoledronic acid 4mg/5mL concentrate for dilution for IV infusion

We wish to inform you that all stakeholders were given 30 days to submit an application for reconsideration, which were re-evaluated with the assistance from the Evidence Review Group.

Attached herewith are the evidence summaries considered by the Council.
