Dear **Secretary Garin**:

After evaluating the documents submitted by the proponents pertinent to requests for reconsideration on the inclusion of the below listed medicines to the Philippine National Formulary (PNF), the Formulary Executive Council (FEC) respectfully recommends the **DISAPPROVAL** of the said requests:

1. Pneumococcal Polysaccharide and Non-typeable H.influenzae (NTHi) Protein D Conjugate vaccine (PCV 10), 0.5 mL suspension for IM injection
2. Live Attenuated Rotavirus Vaccine NLT $10^{6.0}$ ccID₅₀/1.5 mL oral suspension
3. Live Attenuated Rotavirus Vaccine NLT $10^{6.0}$ cc ID₅₀/mL Freeze Dried Powder for Reconstitution (Oral Administration) [Human Strain]
4. Rotavirus Vaccine, Live, Oral Pentavalent G1 2.2×10^6 infectious units, G2 2.8×10^6 infectious units, G3 2.2×10^6 infectious units, G4 2.0×10^6
5. Vildagliptin 50 mg tablet

We wish to inform you that all stakeholders were given 30 days to submit an application for reconsideration, which were re-evaluated with the assistance from the Evidence Review Group.
