CERTIFICATION

This is to certify the one (1) year provisional exemption from Executive Order No. 49 s. 1993 (*Directing the Mandatory Use of the Philippine National Drug Formulary (PNDF) Volume I as the Basis for Procurement of Drug Products by the Government*), effective upon receipt of this certificate, of the following medicine:


Medicine: **Micronutrient powder, oral (per 1 g sachet)**

Vitamin A	400 microgram RE
Vitamin C	30 mg
Vitamin D	5 microgram
Vitamin E	5 mg α -TE
Vitamin B1	0.5 mg
Vitamin B2	0.5 mg
Vitamin B6	0.5 mg
Vitamin B12	0.9 microgram
Folic acid	90 microgram
Niacin	6 mg
Iron	10 mg
Zinc	4.1 mg
Copper	0.56 mg
Iodine	90 microgram
Selenium	17 microgram

Indication: Prevent vitamin and mineral deficiencies; improve iron status and reduce anemia among infants and children 6-23 months of age.

The product shall only be utilized by the requesting party – the Health Emergency Management Bureau (HEMB). Likewise, the concerned proponent shall provide the Formulary Executive Council (FEC), through the Pharmaceutical Division, the following documents at the end of exemption validity: (1) local efficacy and safety profile; (2) surveillance report on adverse effects; (3) registry of patients; and (4) impact study/outcomes of patients using the product.
